


COMMUNITY DINNER

From the Pastor...


United Presbyterian,

Happy New Year to each of you! While we didn't have snow on Christmas this year up in Superior, which was pretty shocking and a little sad, we had a wonderful Advent: A fantastic brunch to finish out our Fall small groups, a Christmas Concert, an incredible children's Christmas pageant, a Lessons and Carols service, and a wonderful Christmas Eve candlelight service to only name some of the highlights. In the midst of all of that, we were giving out Christmas baskets with food and gifts for families, holding a Christmas community dinner, and helping folks in the community with furniture, utilities, home repairs and more. It was a full and meaningful Advent and Christmas season and that is just scratching the surface.

I'm really proud of the deep relationships we continue to develop as a congregation and the work and service we do here in the community as a church. It's in our DNA as Christians to serve and do so together. For us however, it's more, it's a part of our worship just as much as our time Sunday mornings are considered worship. People in the community have heard and witnessed this and have reached out to take us up on that.

Remember this past Spring when we said that we were partnering with Great Lakes, our actual physical neighbors? Well, in December several teachers reached out to us to see if we could assist the school with their reading program. After we met, it was clear that this was some of the work we were called to as a community. On January 7th, two teachers will be coming into speak to the congregation during our worship service about how we get to volunteer for their reading program by spending as little as 30 minutes once a week to assist elementary students with reading. After the service everyone will have the opportunity to sign up for a slot to listen to kids read. In addition, we will have the opportunity to provide small prizes for the reading programs gift drawer. This is just the beginning of our partnership and we look forward to seeing how it grows. A huge thank you to the staff over at Great Lakes for trusting us with this work.

I've asked folks this question rhetorically: If we weren't doing this kind of work in Superior what else would we be doing? Right? This is a part of our purpose as followers of Jesus. As we go into 2024 as a congregation, I'm truly looking forward to how God uses us through the
