What a beautiful start to the new year we've had—full of baptisms!





From the Pastor

Hello United!

January was one of the busiest months of ministry to date here at UPC. I'm so very proud of the work we've done over the last month that will set us in good stead over the coming year. Baptisms, our Annual Meeting and election of new Deacons and Elders, a surprise graduation celebration, our annual Birthday potluck and more all took place.

I am incredibly grateful for this congregation. After the Nominating committee finished it's daunting work with a little unprecedented help from the congregation we have an excellent slate of Deacons and Elders to serve our congregation, Superior, the Twin Ports, and the world in the coming years.

"I've never seen this in my time as a Presbyterian." What an incredible statement. At our annual meeting we had 3 nominations to fill one spot left on our Elder slate. I've never seen a congregation so willing to serve and lead and this shows how willing you all are. I can tell you, also as a Presbyterian for some time, I've never witnessed that before either. Speaking of callings, Laura Foote presented her call to ministry to Session and was accepted as an Inquirer with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A) in January. She is going under the care of UPC and the Presbytery of Northern Waters. "What does that mean?" you might ask. That means that Laura is beginning the long discernment process alongside UPC and the Presbytery to determine if she is called to ordained ministry as a Minister of Word & Sacrament in Christ's church.
