July was quite restful. I'm not that old (yet!) but I've learned in my life that sometimes it is "work" to intentionally slow down. To not have meetings meant there had to be lots of extra communication between people to ensure church still happened. Thank you to the many committee chairs, members, and staff empowered by the Holy Spirit who make United the beloved community that it is.

Fall is shaping up nicely at UPC, our Seminary intern Jocelyn Langholz is settling into her role here. You've probably noticed her at Volleyball, in worship, working with committees or somewhere else. A reminder from Jocelyn that there is a dedicated spot for 1-2 people from United to join her on a service learning trip to the Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota, September 20-27. Our Spiritual Formation Small Group Committee have been hard at work preparing for our Fall Small Groups. This Small Group Bible Study has been requested HEAVILY by y'all over the last two years so we are excited to roll it out. Be on the lookout...it's "for normal people!"

The grant we received to refresh our physical campus has officially been fulfilled with the completion of the parking lot resurfacing. New carpet, accessible egress sidewalks, repainting our bell tower, and resurfacing the parking lot has all been completed over the last few months. Thank you again to the City of Superior!

Speaking of grants, over the last 15 years we've supported Rev. Joshua Heikkila, Mission Coworker to Ghana & West Africa. This Spring Rev. Heikkila invited a small group of people from UPC to attend the Ghana Mission Network Conference of the PC(USA) in partnership with the Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Ghana and the Presbyterian Church of Ghana in Tema, Ghana this October. The hope in attending is to expand our ministry and partnerships with churches in Ghana. Members of UPC worked hard to write a grant to send a small team and were approved. Look out for more info from the delegation soon!

I spent the last week of July paddling and portaging in the Boundary Waters. Most of the timeout on the water, I spent reading Thomas Merton. I'm letting these words guide me into August as we continue our ministry here in Superior: "Every moment and event of every person's life on earth plants something in their soul. For just as the wind carries thousands of winged seeds, so each moment brings with it germs of spiritual vitality that come to rest imperceptibly in the minds and wills of people." I'm praying each of our seeds will grow.
