# **COMMUNITY DINNER** December 18



From the Pastor...

United,

December is upon us and though it started in November, I wanted to say "Welcome to the Advent season!" from all of us here at United Presbyterian Church. In the more liturgical church traditions (think Lutherans, Presbyterians, Episcopalians, and others) who follow the liturgical calendar, we celebrate Advent as a period of waiting before we celebrate Christmas. We sing Advent Hymns, use Advent texts in our liturgy, we talk a lot about waiting, we use Advent calendars to mark down the days, we have Advent devotionals dedicated to us connecting with our families of origin and faith in the days leading up to Christmas. I read an Instagram post from Rev. Lizzie McManus, pastor of Jubilee Episcopal church in Texas recently- she said: "Advent is not just the church being a bit stodgy and making us wait for Christmas; Advent is the church embracing the sensual and holy power of anticipation." It may be a misconception, but I believe that's a prevailing perception of how the church is viewed in society because we celebrate Advent, stodgy. Why not just celebrate Christmas in the church the day after Thanksgiving all the way up to Christmas Eve? It's because we believe, there is something deeply meaningful in the acts of waiting and anticipation. We wait as Mary waited 9 months for Christ. Anticipation and waiting is inherently Christian, it is essential to our story. We try to hold space for holy anticipation during this time as we await Christmas. Your pastor is stodgy, celebrating a period of waiting and anticipation that is built in to the life of Jesus, definitely not. Despite Laura's persistence, I will not go out, cut down, and put up a tree before Thanksgiving or watch Christmas movies before their appointed time (Black Friday and on.) I admittedly, don't have a good reason.

This month many of us will complete the inaugural journey our Spiritual Formation Committee has brought us on. What a journey it has been. I can write confidently that engaging with Rachel Held-Evans' work Inspired, as well as scripture has been meaningful as a pastor in my relationship's with God and the Bible. The committee knew that the book would "stretch" everyone who participated and it did. I heard comments such as "I've never questioned that before." and "THAT is in the Bible? No way." to questions asking if "Jesus really was political?" I heard people mention that the book put words to the feelings and questions they've had in their hearts for some time. It provided comfort and sometimes, pushed our buttons. From the pre internal speculation that the committee had, some weren't sure 12 folks would sign up. Much to everyone's surprise, including mine, almost 4 times that amount joined in. Overall, I'm really thankful to our committee, hosts, leaders, and participants for making this an incredible experience for our church community. The committee will be at work putting together our second journey and I can't wait to know what God will lead them to for us as a community. When we engage with the story of God, we realize that in God's story we find our own story!

December is a lively month in the church- Don't miss our Children's Christmas program on Sunday, December 18 or the Christmas Community Dinner that afternoon at 4:00, or our two Christmas Eve services on Saturday, December 24 at 4:00 p.m. & 9:00 p.m. I'd like to wish everyone connected to United a mindful Advent, a Merry Christmas, and a Happy New Year! See you soon.
