We had our quarterly community dinner that served over 100 folks, we had an excellent Spud day with many joining us after the service, we commissioned our group going on the Black Mountain North Carolina Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Trip and we honored our now former intern Jocelyn Langholz.

This month at UPC we ordain our new Deacons and Elders! I introduced you to the incoming Elders and Deacons last month but I want to take a moment to thank the Ruling Elders and Deacons respectively for their service to the church. The Deacons finishing their three year terms are: Beth Lisak, Angel Phillips, and Jackie & Cliff Pananen. Countless visits, phone calls, cards and times preparing and distributing Communion. Likewise, I want to say thank you to the Elders finishing their terms: Kate Long, Erica Schulz, & Jeff Olson. All of that doesn't begin to touch on plenty more that is going on here at UPC from the Ghana Mission Team presenting on March 6 at 4:45p to hearing from the Disaster Assistance team as they share a moment for mission to our students finishing their preparation to be confirmed by the church!
