From the Pastor

Happy New Year United,

Advent and Christmas have been great. Thank you to the many volunteers who came together to make this season incredible at UPC. From cutting down our tree, participating in worship, serving our neighbors with our Christmas Basket ministry, blowing up balloons to throw around the sanctuary for our Laughter & Joy service and more you all have been busy serving God! It is with a grateful heart that I say so long to 2024 and welcome to 2025!

With the close of 2024 also brings with it the end of Jocelyn Langholz's pastoral internship at United Presbyterian. Many of you have been moved by her ministry in such a short time with us. In January we will set a future date to celebrate her ministry among us and wish her well in her next chapter (Which is hopefully passing her ordination exams!) Don't worry she will be leading worship at UPC occasionally in 2025 a few dates are already set! This is not the end of her work at UPC.

January is shaping up to be a full month here at the church. We hope to get our Penpal project between our next door neighbors at Great Lakes Elementary and the Flodan International School in Accra, Ghana up and running. Bubbling will be the promotional materials for our first ever Lenten Small Groups.
