

SF Dates


Children's Church is every Sunday following the Passing the Peace portion of the service.




If you would like to fill any vacancies...

From the Pastor...

United,

I'm back! I've heard so many positives about worship while I was away. Many thanks to our General Presbyter Rev. Rich Blood, candidate for ordination Jocelyn Langholz, and for the Moderator of our Presbytery Rev. Diana Bell for their leadership in worship. Some of you even texted me asking if we could have Bible studies and worship with these folks more often! Thanks is also due to everyone at the church who made it possible for me to be away. Thank you!

I have so much to share from my pilgrimage to the Isle of Iona but won't be able to write everything in this UPBeat. I do want to share a snippet of my journey there: My journey started at 2:15 a.m. when my phone alerted me that my plane had been delayed a few hours. When I called the flight company, they said "nothing to worry about, it's just that the flight crew needs extra rest." So I hopped in my shuttle down to Minneapolis. The shuttle was driven by a former pastor from Duluth. He shared about his ministry and asked me about my time serving at UPC, the woman who was also in the shuttle, asked for resources about working with older adults as she felt called by God to do so but didn't know where to look. We got the opportunity to connect her to places she could serve. It was beautiful.

As I arrived at the airport, I received two more further delays. I now would miss my connecting flight overseas. I called the flight company again and they said, "Sorry, there's nothing we can do. We can possibly get you on a flight tomorrow?" After security I decided to go down to where my flight was supposed to take off from, start praying, and start asking some questions. The first desk I stopped at, after I explained my predicament, they said, "Maybe go talk to that other desk?" I went to that desk, shared my predicament, the man at the desk asked why I was going to Scotland, so I shared about my work at United, some stories from worship and where I was going and why. He said "Wow, that's incredible. I've never heard of a church like that. Give me a second." literally 15 minutes went by of me nervously sitting there, answering little flight questions while he typed away and he eventually said, "you okay skipping the connecting flight all together? We can get you there earlier and in less flights. Only problem is, the flight doesn't take off until 7:30 tonight. Sound good? "That sounds great." I said.

So, I sat in the airport I wasn't supposed to be in anymore and a man, about 5 hours in to my newly minted 13 hour stay asked me for a Mac charger because he just lost his. Through a conversation, I found out he was the COO of Headspace, the mental health app available on most all smart devices. We discussed mental health and the church, my studies in seminary, and his passion for meeting people where they are and his hope to be a resource to faith communities too. I was deeply encouraged.

Eventually I boarded the flight I wasn't supposed to be on that evening, the woman I was sat next to on my flight says... "Did you go to Princeton Seminary by chance? I heard you talking to that man earlier." Through our conversation I found out she was the wife of a Presbyterian minister in Ireland, she was best friends with several of my professors at Princeton, and she had been to Iona. She shared lots of her life and story with me about what it's like serving the church. It was such a blessing.

Eventually, I made it to the United Kingdom and experienced rail strikes, busses, downed trees on railways, ferries, missed public transit and more but made it to Iona. It was a journey. There's a lot more to share but as Euwen, one of the musicians and worship leaders at Iona said a few days after I got there, "Brett, no one comes to Iona by accident." I've learned very clearly to pay attention to the journey as much as the destination. My pilgrimage to Iona taught me a lot about the process of becoming, becoming more like Christ. This journey has shaped and molded me. I'm grateful beyond words.
