# Lake Charles Louisiana Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Work Trip Presbytery of Northern Waters February 11 - 19, 2023



Why Volunteer to Assist Lake Charles: Southern Louisiana experienced extensive flooding in 2016, followed by more damage from hurricane Barry in 2020. In August of 2021 Louisiana was hit once again, by hurricane Laura, a category four storm, with accompanying tornadoes. Requirements: Must be at least 16-years old, be in good health, and have health insurance. Those under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

Abilities: Experience is helpful but not necessary! Experience and/or a willingness to learn the following are needed: drywall, flooring, painting, siding, gutting, and roofing Accommodations and Transportation: We will be staying at Olivet Baptist Church. We will be Sleeping bags, linens, and towels will be needed. The church can accommodate a maximum of 20 volunteers, so please register soon! We will carpool down and back. The trip will take two provided with bunk beds or cots, a shower trailer, and a kitchen. RV hook ups are available. days each way with an overnight stop at a hotel.

Cost: The total cost is approximately \$350 per person. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person should be included with your registration. 
