From the Pastor...

United,

2022 is already moving faster than 2021 did in my mind! We had our annual meeting in January. During our meeting we filled out some of the great work already done by our nominating committee. The slate of leaders we have for our church is something I am immensely proud of and are people I am really looking forward to working with. As I said in my annual report and my sermon the morning of the meeting, last year was a year of foundation laying and rebuilding. Our nursery is operational and organized, our capacity to serve meals to folks has grown, our technology has made worship more accessible than ever, Personnel has created a first staff handbook for UPC. There is still much work to be done both organizationally, programmatically, and most importantly, spiritually over the next year. We have the people to make it happen and for that I'm grateful.

Speaking of foundation laying, you know those apartments that are being built across from our church campus on Bardon Ave? See what I did there? Ha! If you didn't, there are apartments being built by P&R properties with a similar layout to the new apartments on Belknap Street in Superior named Central Flats. Your session and Building and Grounds have negotiated and entered into an agreement to share our parking lot with P&R properties construction workers during their build that will begin close to the end of February. More information will be forthcoming in a separate letter to everyone but here are a few key points you should know about the agreement: During the weekdays P&R has requested use of 50 parking spots. There will be no heavy equipment parked on our lot. During the week we will have around 10 parking spaces to use for our daily office/church work needs. There is special dispensation for us to use the entire parking lot for weddings, funerals, and special events that we schedule. This agreement has no effect on Sundays and most Saturdays. P&R has agreed to financially compensate the church and to help plow and push back snow. We are looking forward to beginning our relationship by putting a good foot forward and we are excited to partner with this company who will be our neighbor for many years to come. Look for a letter detailing everything to be at your homes in the coming weeks.

As we look at our daily lives: events are being cancelled, church is taking new precautions temporarily, Covid numbers are rising, people we know and love are getting the virus and I, alongside so many of you, am tired. So much of our lives have changed over the past two years. Fear abounds in both the reality of our lives and the realities we create. It's easy to feel powerless over your and our collective circumstances. Despite all that is going on, United will continue to do the work of God in the midst of difficulty all around the world. Much of that work is in the alleviating of God reminds us, as he did for the young prophet Jeremiah "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you." God knew us, God called us, and God made us to be representatives of Christ no matter the season we are in. I'm personally excited for all that is taking place at the church. We are in such a unique position to grow deeper spiritually and wider in our outreach.

If you find yourself getting overwhelmed at any point in this coming month whether it be from watching the newsier a situation that's going on in your life, try stopping for a moment and repeating the Christian Mystic, Julian of Norwich's famous words she attributes to Christ when worried about the state of the world "all shall be well, and all shall be well, and all manner of thing shall be well."
