Each month, one committee will talk about what they do and how their work makes a difference at UPC and in the greater Superior community. Essentially, your tithe and offering dollars at work. July is Mission Committee. Below you can read on to see what they are doing and what could be possible with increased funding.

MISSION COMMITTEE

The Mission Committee is committed to the goal of making Superior a better place because UPC is a part of it.

We reach out to the hungry, possibly lonely or just curious, through our quarterly free community dinners. The last dinner, on Father's Day, was well attended and everyone enjoyed the cornhole tournament. The next dinner will be August 17th. Menu includes chicken salad with croissant, fruit, chips and ice cream cups. We are still looking for a volunteer to lead this ministry.

Through a new partnership with UWS, we will be reaching out to students who may need food, bedding, or other necessities. Items needed are listed on the baskets in the Donation Center in the narthex. This is an exciting way to reach out to new people in the community.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, our efforts to help refugees come to the Twin Ports area are unfortunately on hold. But thanks to the overwhelming generosity of the congregation, almost a year ago we played "Bingo for Nargis". We were able to present her with two huge baskets of welcome gifts. She has settled into a place in Duluth, works at Fitger's, is doing really well navigating public transportation and learning English.

Last year we provided amazing gifts and a basket of food for 25 families at Christmas. There will be more about this during Moments for Mission during July.

Of course we can't forget the Community Garden! It is well on it's way to being another successful growing season and harvest.

Thanks to everyone who donated supplies and stayed after the service last Sunday to put together our summer homeless kits. They probably seem like a small thing, but we may never know how much that bag of snacks, toiletries and information means to a homeless person.

From the Pastor

United Presbyterian,

June was lively. We started off the month Graduation Sunday, honoring our graduates from Kindergarten through college. Then your pastor, staff, and several volunteers were involved in planning and leading the community VBS over at Concordia Lutheran Church in Superior. We also put on a new roof here at UPC and we prayed over it and rededicated our church to the work of uplifting our community in Jesus' name here in the Twin Ports.

In the midst of all those incredible happenings we: held a 25th anniversary vow renewal for a couple in the church, I swapped pulpits with Rev.
